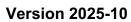

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# **Chapter 1: Introduction**

#### Introduction

The PatrolBot™ is an intelligent chatbot designed to answer user questions about PatrolSuite™, drawing directly from the application's User Guides and related documentation. As part of the broader PatrolSuite ecosystem, PatrolBot helps bridge the gap between users and the system's knowledge base, providing ondemand guidance and context-sensitive support.

PatrolBot aims to reduce the delay between when an operator needs software help and when the operator receives help, while also minimizing the time Quality Administrators spend answering "how-to-use-thesoftware" questions.

PatrolBot is accessible to all authorized users through the PatrolSuite interface.

#### Access

Contact your IT department for URL and login credential information to access the PatrolSuite homepage.

Access to PatrolSuite modules is managed by a combination of PatrolSuite and Active Directory security. Accordingly, not all users will see the same PatrolSuite homepage contents, and not all users will have readwrite or edit capability for all modules. Contact your IT department with questions regarding security and permissions.

#### **Browser**

The PatrolBot is accessed via a browser. PatrolSuite, and all its apps such as PatrolBot, are certified to the following browsers: Google Chrome, Microsoft Edge, or Safari. MAP strongly recommends using only these browsers. Contact your IT department to obtain the URL to access the PatrolSuite homepage from where the PatrolBot app can be accessed.

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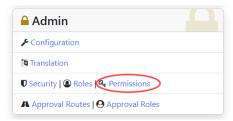


# **Chapter 2: Security**

#### Permissions

Permissions are located on Page: {PatrolSuite URL}/Security/Permissions

1. To access the PatrolBot permissions, click on the Permissions hyperlink in the Admin card on the PatrolSuite homepage.



2. Scroll down to the PatrolBot section.

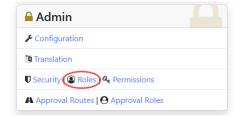
Note: Permissions cannot be created; they are pre-defined. Please contact MAP if you have justification that supports adding a new permission.

3. To view the users who have been granted a permission, click on the permission name.



### Roles

Roles are located on Page: {PatrolSuite URL}/Security/Roles



To grant a user a permission, the user must be placed into a Role that has the permission activated. Roles are user defined. There are two options for approaching PatrolBot security.

I. Do not create any PatrolBot roles. Instead, grant the PatrolBot view permission to existing roles as desired.

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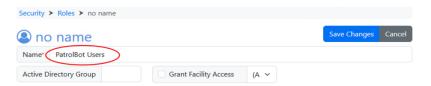


II. Create a PatrolBot role called "PatrolBot Users." Grant the PatrolBot view permission to this role. Create the corresponding Active Directory group and add the desired PatrolBot users into this group. Then associate this group with the role called "PatrolBot Users."

4. To create a Role, click on the 'Add New Role' button.



5. Enter the name of the role and click 'Save Changes'.



PatrolSuite security is integrated with Microsoft Active Directory. Each PatrolSuite Role must be associated with an Active Directory group.



- 6. Contact your IT department and request creating an Active Directory group for each PatrolBot Role. The Active Directory group names are typically the same as the PatrolBot Role name.
  - a. Provide the IT department with the names of all users who need to be added into each Active Directory group.
- 7. To associate the Active Directory group with the Role:
  - Click on the desired Role name.

c. Enter the name of the applicable Active Directory group and click 'Save Changes.'



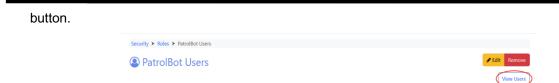
Note: Granting facility access is typically not done for a PatrolBot Role. Accordingly, MAP recommends leaving the Grant Facility Access checkbox unchecked.

8. To see the users who are in the Active Directory group associated with the Role, click the 'View Users'



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- 9. To grant permissions to a PatrolBot Role:
  - a. Click on the desired Role name.



b. Scroll down to the PatrolBot section and click on the 'No' button for the permission named "PatrolBot Users." This will change the button to read 'Yes' which means the permission has been granted to the Role, and therefore to all users in the Role.



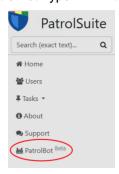


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# Chapter 3: Chat

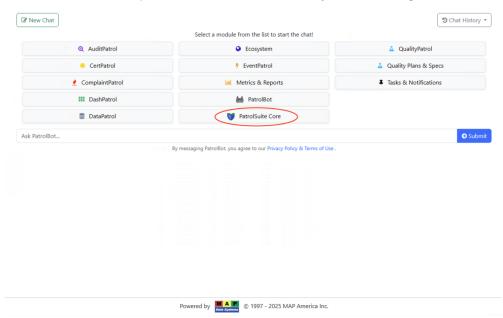
#### **Access to PatrolBot**

10. To access PatrolBot, click on the PatrolBot hyperlink in the navigation bar on the PatrolSuite homepage.



### **Ask PatrolBot a Question**

11. Click the button that corresponds to the module for which you are seeking assistance.

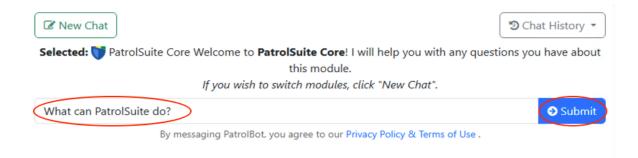


12. Click into the question field, type your question, and click the 'Submit' button.

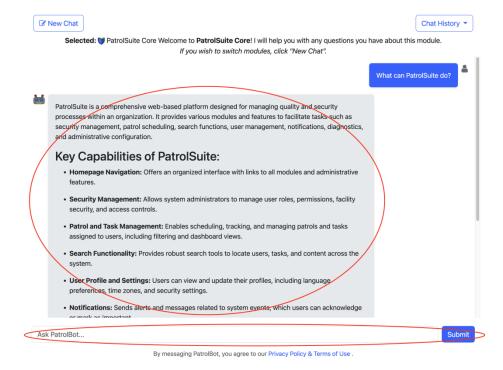
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13. View the answer and continue asking questions until you get the information you need.



14. If you want to ask a question related to another module, click 'New Chat' and then select the desired module.

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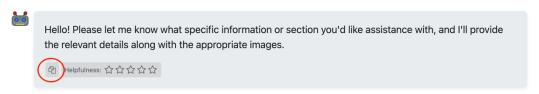






# **Copy & Rate Answers**

15. To copy an answer, click on the Clipboard icon next to the response. The text will be copied to your clipboard.



16. To rate the helpfulness of a response, click on the appropriate star from 1 to 5.

1 Not helpful; 2 Somewhat helpful; 3 Moderately helpful; 4 Very helpful; 5 Rock star helpful.



Note: To see the rating of a star, hold your curser over the star.



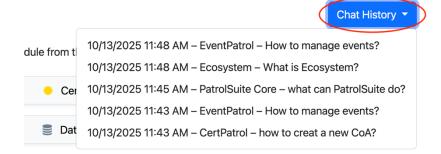
## **View Chat History**

17. To view your most recent five conversations, click 'Chat History' and select the desired chat from the dropdown menu.





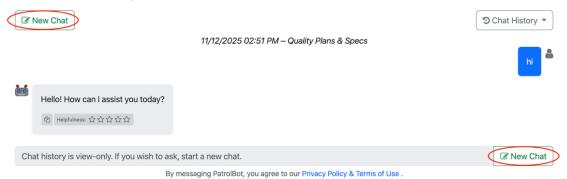




The Chat History page will appear. This page is view-only, meaning you can review past interactions but cannot continue asking questions there.

Note: Click on a star to rate PatrolBot's helpfulness, or to update a previous rating.

Note: To ask new questions, click 'New Chat' to start a new conversation.



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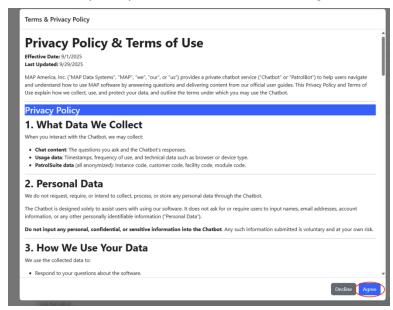


# **Terms of Use**

#### Introduction

There are two circumstances that require a user to agree to the PatrolBot Privacy Policy and Terms of

- When a user first opens PatrolBot, the user must read and agree to the Privacy Policy and Terms of Use before PatrolBot access is granted.
- When the PatrolBot Privacy Policy and Terms of Use change, the user must read and agree to the Privacy Policy and Terms of Use before PatrolBot access is granted.
- 18. To agree to the PatrolBot Privacy Policy and Terms of Use, click the 'Agree' button.





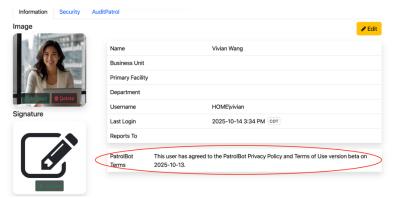
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# **Agreed Version**

19. Each user's agreement to the PatrolBot Privacy Policy and Terms of Use is recorded. To view the agreement, click your username in the navigation bar and then select 'User Info' from the dropdown list.
